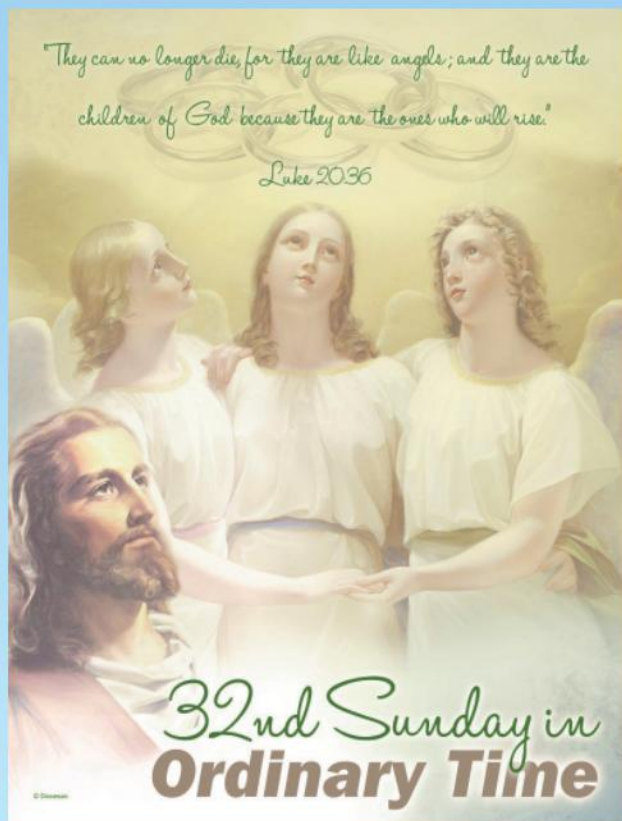

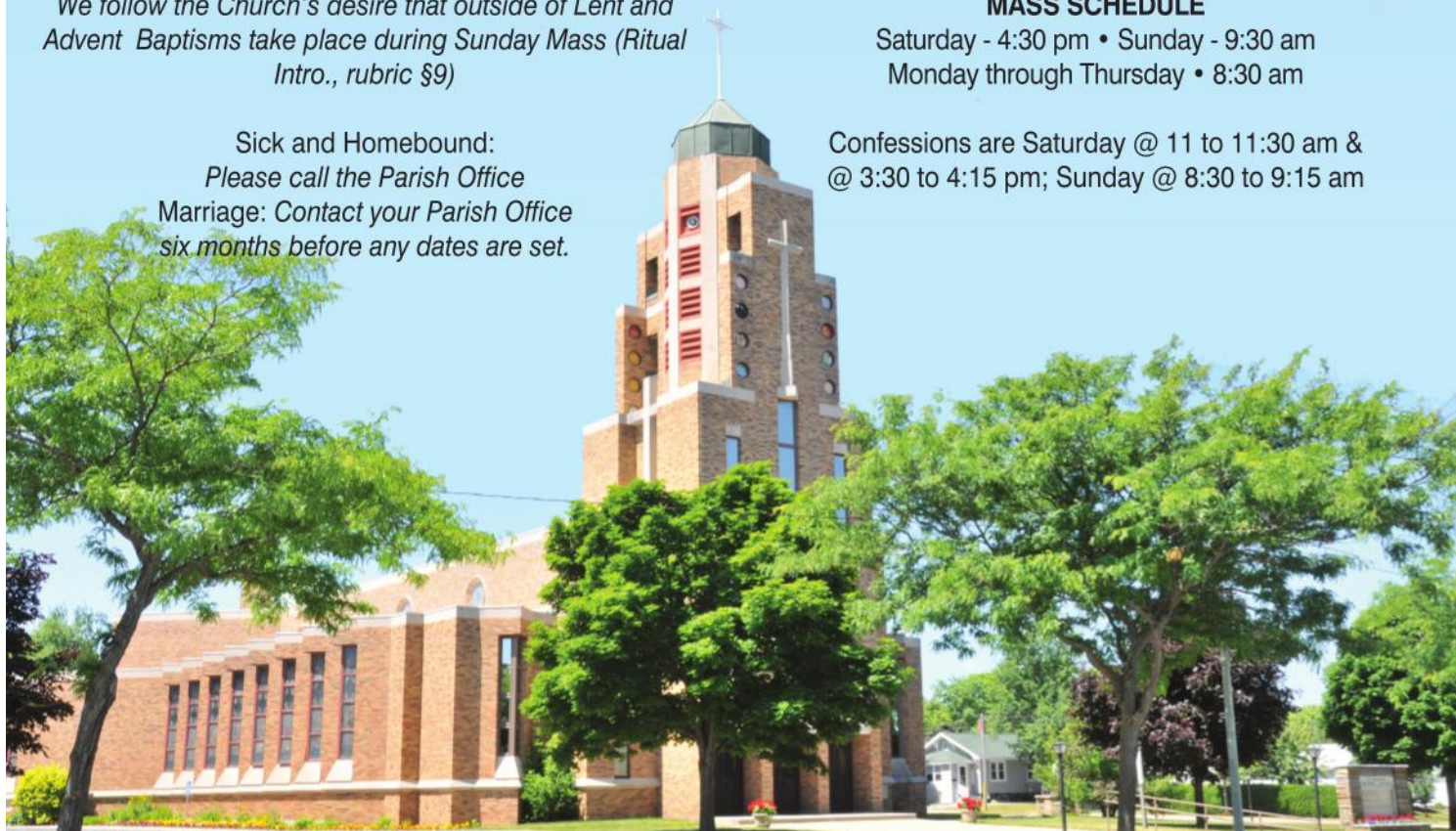

History of St. Ignatius of Loyola Catholic Church

Concerning our Associate Pastors:

“Though they come and go and stay all too brief a time, it is no small matter and no little impact which the nearly two dozen Assistant Pastors have made in the 42 years from Fr. John Kucinski to Fr. T.C. Howard. They are the pastor’s right hand man – part of a team. They serve as the “buffer zone” between the people and the pastor. They each bring the gift of a unique and special personality through which God bestows blessings upon the parish that would not otherwise come at all. And it is no small matter to minister at the Baptismal Font to hundreds of converts and thousands of infants; to bring Christ’s forgiveness to tens of thousands, the Eucharist to hundreds of thousands. How many thousands were joined in Christian marriage with their assistance? Add to these the untold hours of comfort to the sick and dying. Through their hands the Healing Christ has touched the heart and conscience of this whole parish.

Counting by the years 300 Sisters of Mercy have given the spirit and light of Christ to over 20,000 parishioners. God bless them for still wearing the sign of their Vocation in this day when so many people are embarrassed before men to show the symbol of their vows to God. Only God knows how many religious vocations they have inspired.

Can we overlook the example of literally hundreds of men and women who gather at the altar of this church to create the environment from which came our 10 native Sisters, 8 native Priests, and one Holy Cross Brother. Numbered among these daily Communicants invariably would be the parents of our Priests, Sisters, and Brother.

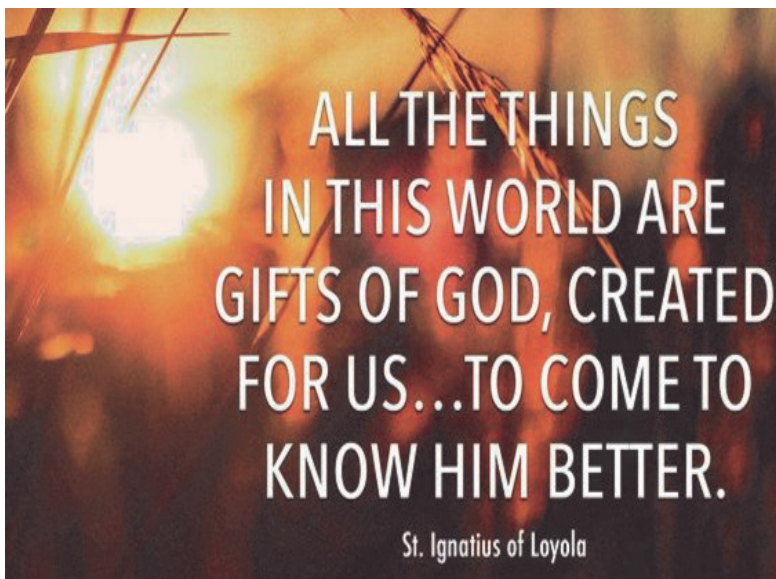
Reflection

Luther nailed his theses to the church door at Wittenberg in 1517. Seventeen years later, Ignatius of Loyola founded the Society that was to play so prominent a part in the Catholic Reformation. He was an implacable foe of Protestantism. Yet the seeds of ecumenism may be found in his words: “Great care must be taken to show forth orthodox truth in such a way that if any heretics happen to be present they may have an example of charity and Christian moderation. No hard words should be used nor any sort of contempt for their errors be shown”.

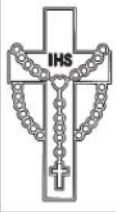
