

## From the Desk of Fr. Don,

If you are reading this you are probably an active Catholic and know that the celebration of the Eucharist is the center of our faith life. The **funeral Mass** is the most powerful prayer we can offer for you and your family in their grief. It can also be a great time of evangelization for those who may not be practicing their faith on a regular basis. I know from my own experience, when my father died during my teen years, what a powerful experience it is when the parish community rallies around a family in this time of loss and searching. This power of the faith community is much more visible when the celebration takes place in church rather than at the funeral home.

Unfortunately, we are seeing fewer families take advantage of this blessing these days. It may be because the children of the deceased no longer practice their faith, or because the deceased did not make his or her intentions clear. So please let your family know that you want a funeral Mass. Ask the funeral home and the parish to record your wishes in advance. Put it in writing and give everyone a copy. And it is a big help if you pick out scripture readings and music in advance. We can help you with all of these details.
